



Wedding Music Agreement

1. Upon the signing of this agreement and payment of a non-refundable 50% retainer fee, the musician will reserve the date and time agreed upon and will not make another reservation for the specific time frame. If the client changes the date or time, the musician reserves the right to cancel the booking if a mutually agreeable reschedule date is not available.
2. The musician's standard fee will include a consultation, pre-ceremony music and instrumental and vocal selections during the ceremony. There is a \$75 fee to attend the wedding rehearsal.
3. Weddings outside of the Saint John area will incur a travel fee to be determined by location.
4. Should additional musicians be involved in the ceremony, contact information must be provided so collaboration between musicians can be arranged. Additional rehearsal fees will apply at a rate of \$50/hour.
5. Any music that must be purchased by the musician will incur a fee of \$10/song.
6. If the musician cannot uphold this agreement in whole or part, the musician will return any and all fees to the client(s) but shall have no further liability with respect to this agreement.
